

- DESTINATION:** We are headed to the Kitsap Peninsula for a weekend of exploring Navy history and will be spending the night aboard the USS Turner Joy. On Saturday, troop members will visit the Naval Undersea Museum prior to boarding the USS Turner Joy, a Vietnam Era destroyer maintained by the Bremerton Historic Ships. They will enjoy dinner and breakfast aboard. The following morning, they will explore the Puget Sound Navy Museum before heading home. Please note, we only have room for 20. Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Get your paperwork in today.
- DEPART:** Meet at Wedgwood Presbyterian Church (WPC) parking lot **at 9AM Saturday, April 21** for car load-up and equipment drop off. Troop will depart at 9:30 AM. Rosters, maps, and driving instructions will be provided.

- PROGRAM:** This is a 1-night trip. We will be staying aboard the ship. Dinner, snack, and breakfast will be provided.
- ROUTE:** Arrive at Wedgwood Presbyterian Church at 9am
Leave Wedgwood Presbyterian Church for Edmonds at 9:30am
Edmonds to Kingston Ferry – aim to take 10:30 ferry
Kingston Ferry to Naval Undersea Museum in Keyport– aim to get there by noon
Sack Lunch at Naval Undersea Museum
Naval Undersea Museum to Bremerton – check-in at USS Turner Joy at 5pm*
USS Turner Joy to Puget Sound Naval Museum –Leave vessel at 9:30am and arrive at museum at 10am
Puget Sound Naval Museum to Bremerton Ferry Landing - arrive by 11:30 to catch the 12:20
Park in line for ferry and walk boys over to get lunch at Subway or Fritz European Fry House
Bremerton to Seattle Ferry (if needed, there is more food on-board ferry)
Seattle to Wedgwood Presbyterian Church – arrive by 2pm
**If there is too much free time in afternoon on 4/21 then we may opt to visit the Puget Sound Naval Museum (a day early) before heading to the USS Turner Joy. In that case, we would leave USS Turner Joy on 4/22 and go directly to ferry putting us back in Seattle early.*
- EQUIPMENT:** Sleeping bag, change of weather appropriate clothing, flat rubber-soled shoes (sneakers), camera/film, towel and washcloth, required medications, pillow, rain gear, toothbrush and toothpaste, soap and flashlight.
- FOOD:** Sack lunch for Saturday. Dinner, snack and breakfast will be provided aboard the USS Turner Joy. Bring spending money for lunch on Sunday. Report food allergies and vegetarian/vegan requests to Ms. Heather Smith at heather@russandheather.net by Monday night April 16th.
- FEE:** **\$75 CASH** covers transportation and ferry costs. Scholarships are available. Contact Bill Montgomery at least 1 week prior to the outing.
- RETURN:** See above schedule for details. Scouts will call for pick-up as soon as we are driving off the ferry. We should arrive back at church by 2pm.
- SIGN-UP:** **Signed permission slips** and **\$75 CASH/CHECK** need to be turned in by Monday, April 16th.
