EQUIPMENT This trip is an overnight car camp. Scouts must be prepared for potential wet weather and cold. Patrols are required to bring sufficient tents, tarps and dining flys, water-purification supplies, sufficient large water containers, and coordinate cooking gear, stoves and fuel (campfires are permitted in this area). Troop 166 practices Leave No Trace – i.e. leave only footprints, take only pictures – so bring garbage bags, and plan carefully. Bring your 10+ essentials including extra clothing and rain gear for possible conditions, sun protection, map and compass, water bottle, day pack, snacks, waterproof matches and fire starters, a pocketknife, first-aid kit, flashlight and batteries, overnight camping gear including a warm sleeping bag.

FOOD The patrols are responsible for preparing side dishes on Saturday and breakfast on Sunday. E. Provide your own snacks, and sack lunches for Saturday and Sunday unless your patrol makes other arrangements.

FEE **\$25.00 CASH** covers transportation and camp fees. Provide an additional **\$8.00 CASH** to your patrol (**all** adults, too) for food expenses Scholarships are available. Contact Bill Montgomery at least 5 days prior to the outing. Due to my Disabilites I have rented the yurt on site so this is a great event for Moms who would like to camp warm.
